

Surah Az Zumar.....

Disbelievers try to justify their worship to idols saying that it may bring us closer to Allah. Man must submit and pray to Allah Almighty also and must not associate any partner with Him. This is something he will never forgive.

Believers are told, if it is difficult for them to practice their religion in one place, they can migrate from that land.

Those who have transgressed against their souls should not despair of Allah's mercy, If they are sinful or committed the highest crime (of shirk), they should repent while they can, Allah is oft-forgiving.

Worship Allah and be among His thankful servants and on the Day of Judgement the Book of Deeds will be laid open and justice will be done with all fairness.

Surah (40) Al-Mu'min (Believer)- also known as Surah Ghafir ((Forgiver), Revealed after Surah Az-Zumar

From this surah onward seven Surahs (al-Mu'min, HaMim al-Sajdah, al-Shura, al-Zukhruf, al-Dukhan, al-Jathiyah, al-Ahqaf) that begin with the word "HaMim", hence collectively called " **Ha Mim Group** (حواميم سبع)" **These are Surahs** of Da'wah, inviting people to believe in Allah, take advantage of the mercy of Allah. Abdullah ibn Abbas called them brain of the Quran

Angels seek forgiveness for the believers who repent from their evil ways and adhere to the right path. Angles will not intercede for those who rebel against Allah. This is the best example saying word of truth in front of a tyrannical ruler.

In the backdrop of the conspiracies of murder (of the Prophet), a story of the Believer of the people of Pharaoh has been narrated in a long discourse, who declares his faith.

Disbelievers of Makah have been told that whatever you intend to do against Prophet Muhammad (s.a.w), the same did the Pharaoh with his might against the Prophet Moses. Now, would you like to meet with the same fate with which he met by plotting such conspiracies? The false leaders will take their people to hell.

Allah saved that believer from the plots of Fir'on and destroyed the people of Fir'on. The believers are assured that although the evil ones seem powerful, they will one day prevail against them.

The people who were sitting on the fence were admonished to stand up for the Truth, and not just stand by and let things happen around them.

The arguments in favour of monotheism and the Hereafter found within man and around him. Who made the earth a dwelling place and made sky a canopy, who shaped human being in wombs of their mothers, who provided the required sustenance. Answer is, our blessed Lord; Allah, the Lord of the Universe

Supplication (dua'a) is an expression of obedience – "Pray to Me, and I will accept your prayers"

Surah (41) Fussilat (Made Distinct)- also known as Surah HaMim al-Sajdah, Revealed at Makkah

This Surah continues the theme of the previous chapter and deals with the arrogance of the disbelievers, the truthfulness of the Qur'an, Tawhid and Resurrection.

Quran is a great favour of Allah, people should be thankful for this favor and should believe in and live by this Quran.

Woe to the people who are rejecting this blessing in a very arrogant manner and instead of embracing faith are demanding to see the punishment they are being warned of.

These people have put coverings on their hearts and have made themselves deaf for divine message. It is none of the Prophet's job to make them hear when they don't want to hear or to understand forcibly.

If they persist in their denial and rejection, then be aware that a sudden torment is about to visit, the like of which had visited the A'ad and the Thamud.

This Quran is an unchangeable Book. It can not be defeated by falsehoods an people wishes.

The best in speech is the one who calls people towards Allah, do good deeds and say, I am a Muslim (obedient to Allah).

Horrific fate of denying the Qur'an is alluded - Have you ever considered that if this Quran is really from Allah and you deny it, what will happen to you?

Testimony on truthfulness of Quran- Soon shall We show them Our Signs on the horizons and in their own beings until it becomes clear to them that it is the Truth. These signs unfolding one by one in flow of time and testifying the claim.
